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SUBJECT-MATTER OF THE PUBLIC CONTRACT

The subject of the public contract is the provision of **post-warranty maintenance services for three small laboratory animal imaging systems nanoScan PET/CT (NH-106067-PC), nanoScan PET/MRI 3T (RD000000-0004V2) and nanoScan SPECT/CT (NY-305142-4RCT) from Mediso Medical Imaging Systems Ltd**, which are owned by the Contracting Authority and installed at Institute of Molecular and Translational Medicine, Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, Palacký University in Olomouc (nanoScan PET/CT - inv. no. 3275994, year of acquisition: 2022; nanoScan PET/MRI 3T - inv. no. 3276719, year of acquisition: 2022; nanoScan SPECT/CT - inv. no. 3284023, year of acquisition: 2023), which is to ensure trouble-free operation in conditions of intensive load of the devices during the performance of research tasks.

The description and scope of the service contract is set out in the attached terms and conditions (Annex 3 of the procurement documentation).

In accordance with procurement conditions the service agreement was concluded with the above-mentioned selected economic operator on the 31 July 2024.

REASONS FOR SELECTION OF THE ECONOMIC OPERATOR:

The evaluation criterion of economic advantage was the lowest tender price.

In accordance with Section 122(2) of the Act, the Contracting Authority did not evaluate tenders, because there was only one participant in the procurement procedure.

Within the limits set by the Act and the facts of the case, the Contracting Authority intends to use the negotiated procedure without prior publication within the meaning of Section 63(3)(b) and (c) and pursuant to Section 67(1) of the Act for the purpose of awarding this public contract, as the **Invited Supplier named below is the exclusive provider of warranty and post-warranty service of the nanoScan PET/CT, nanoScan PET/MRI 3T and nanoScan SPECT/CT small animal imaging systems from Mediso Medical Imaging Systems Ltd.**

The procedure of the Contracting Authority to carry out the public contract in question in the mode of the negotiated procedure without prior publication is the only possible one, taking into account the obligation to fulfil the duties of a sound economic manager, as well as to dispose of all assets conscientiously and, last but not least, it is considered to be in line with the 3E principles. Furthermore, the Contracting Authority notes that for technical reasons, the servicing of the installed technology cannot be carried out by a supplier other than the equipment manufacturer, and therefore it is not **possible to address or involve more than one supplier in the procurement procedure, and the procedure by means of a negotiated procedure without prior publication on the basis of the provisions of Article 63(3)(b) and (c) of the Act is therefore the only possible one.**

The procurement procedure was not canceled.

The public contract is not divided into lots, as the subject of the public contract consists of the provision of maintenance services for three systems of a single manufacturer, which are owned by the Contracting Authority, which are authorized to be provided by a single supplier. The splitting of the contract into lots is therefore completely meaningless and would not provide any benefit to the Contracting Authority in the context of this procurement. There is no discrimination in this procedure.
