According to the public supply contract awarded in the above-threshold regime setting up of a dynamic purchasing system in accordance with provisions of Section 138 et seq of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., Public Procurement Act, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), entitled "Dynamic purchasing system of collection of chemical compounds for automated chemical libraries for the Palacký University Olomouc (2023-2026)", published in the national Tenders Electronic Daily under Reg. Question No.1:

Answer:

The question: Is the procurement documentation - request for participation available in Czech language?

The answer: The procurement documentation is prepared in English (see Article 1 of the procurement documentation). The request for participation must be made in full in writing in electronic form and in Czech, Slovak or English (see Article 7 of the procurement documentation).



Question No.2:

The answer: The language of the procurement documentation will be determined at the time of the award of each individual tender in the DPS.
